From the Executive Director, Debbie Geist

What does it mean to be pro-life? I have always considered myself "pro-life" and have been actively involved in the movement for over 16 years. I am proud to stand for the life-affirming mission of Life Network and many other pro-life organizations. I am compelled by the core message of the Bible – that God created ALL life in his own image and that we are called to help rescue the most vulnerable. It is not something that I just say - but something that I try to live out in every aspect of my life.

With that said, there are certain elements to participating in this work that are more difficult than others. In many circles, the word "pro-life" or "abortion" can cause tensions

to rise quickly and emotions to go unchecked. Women who view legal abortion as a fundamental right or health care may fear losing that freedom. Men may stand with the pro-abortion crowd to be politically correct or because they are not sure what to believe. Some folks who are uncomfortable with the idea of abortion may waver with the hard questions

like, "What about in the case of rape?" Today, the word "pro-life" too easily conjures up negative images or thoughts in people's minds because of abortion advocates who have worked long and hard to deaden our conscience when it comes to protecting the most vulnerable among us.

Since the Roe v Wade decision 48 years ago, over 62 million babies have fallen victim to this injustice and pro-life supporters and organizations like Life Network have been targets of unfounded attacks and misguided media. They would like nothing more than to silence us and tell us that we are narrow minded and refuse to see the big picture. While I do admit, there are extremist on both sides of the issue, the beautiful work done by pregnancy care centers around the nation is often dismissed as "fake" or "intolerant" of those facing the crises of an unplanned pregnancy. That is simply NOT TRUE.

This misconception about pregnancy care centers and the work we do is extremely disheartening. Our goal is to never mislead or coerce anyone but to empower them. We are not mean or insensitive to their situation and we are not trying to prove a point or take away their freedom to choose. In fact, quite the opposite is true. The overarching theme of pregnancy care center work is LOVE – love for the pre-born, love for their moms and dads, love for God. We care deeply about the women we serve and believe, that for them to make an informed decision, they need education and hope for the future. We want to offer them practical help and alternatives to abortion – not take

away their choice.

Part of that education is sharing the truth with them about their developing baby – at all stages of pregnancy. During Roe v Wade we lacked the scientific technology to answer the important question – is it really a baby? Now, thanks to medical technology and imaging techniques we no longer need to ponder that question. An ultrasound gives us the privilege of observing the developing life within the womb and allows us to see the heart beating at just

21 days after fertilization. At 3 months (which is what the original Roe v Wade decision was based on) we can see that the baby has all the major organ systems and is a distinctly recognizable human being. That is critical information when trying to make a decision about "life" and we would be doing our clients a disservice if we did not share it with them.

We are not a "fake clinic" or intolerant of those that come to us overwhelmed with a crisis pregnancy. Our objective is to be a safe place of compassion, understanding, and truth for them as they contemplate perhaps one of the hardest decisions they will ever make. We pray that our work and the work of our WONDERFUL supporters is seen as the ultimate example of what it means to be "pro-life".




