Trying to capture the essence of a ministry like Life Network can be difficult because there are so many layers and so many important people that make the ministry successful. Unfortunately, there continues to be much falsehood when it comes to the work done at pregnancy care centers, so I thought I would take a few minutes to address a couple of questions and share some pertinent information with you regarding our organization.

WHY DO WE EXIST? In short, pregnancy resource centers exist to be a voice for the pre-born and to provide a safe nonjudgemental place for men and women who are facing an unplanned or unexpected pregnancy. Contrary to some media and social outlets, we are not here to coerce, scare or force anyone into a decision, but to provide TRUTH and necessary resources so they can determine what is best regarding their future and the future of their baby. We do NOT refer for abortion, but always strive to treat everyone with the utmost respect – including the life of the pre-born.

ARE ALL CLIENTS THE SAME? Absolutely not! I can say, without hesitation, that each day brings its own set of challenges and every client that walks through our doors is unique. Whether we see one client or five clients in a day — each situation is different. We offer a wide variety of services, therefore enabling us to not only assist them with their immediate need, but to INVEST in their long-term well-being. Regardless of their need — parenting classes, professional counseling, baby resources, pregnancy options counseling/assistance or just needing someone to talk with, we are here to help.

DO WE EVER GET DISCOURAGED? Unfortunately, the answer to this question is YES! Ministry can be difficult and trying to find the right balance between TRUTH and NON-JUDGEMENT is not always easy. When clients come in with preconceived ideas regarding the termination of their pregnancy and no matter what we say or resources we offer, they choose to end the life of their baby, our hearts break. Today's culture has done an excellent job of confusing and deceiving when it comes to life in the womb. Mail order abortion pill access (RU486) has become the norm and fairly easy to obtain, therefore making it difficult to counteract. Thankfully, on average approximately 98% of our clients choose LIFE and for that we are grateful.

We also see clients that have been court ordered to participate in our parenting classes because of drug/alcohol addiction or other issues. We do our best to give them the education and encouragement they need to change their path and regain custody of their children, however addiction can be a challenge without on-going intervention. We are always thrilled when they are successful, but saddened at those that are not.

HOW IS LIFE NETWORK GOVERNED? Life Network is affiliated with two large pro-life organizations – Care Net and Heartbeat International as well as a legal organization called NIFLA. These organizations support the world's largest network of crises pregnancy centers, with over two thousand affiliates in fifty countries. These organizations assist pregnancy care centers like Life Network with policies, procedures, guidelines, and legal recommendations to ensure legitimate and ethical oversight of all the services provided via our ministry.

Locally, Life Network is governed by a 7-to-10-member Board of Directors which consists of both men and women - from various occupational and faith backgrounds. This group of volunteers is the "silent backbone" of our ministry and is committed to the purposes and objectives of the center. They set policy, create and implement the bylaws of the corporation, represent the center in legal matters and oversee finances and properties of the center. They also hire and evaluate the Executive Director. As Executive Director of this ministry for over 14 years I can tell you that they have been my greatest support, and I am eternally grateful for them.

HOW CAN I GET INVOLVED IN YOUR MISSION? Besides our office volunteers (which are always welcome) our prayer warriors are invaluable to us and an essential part of our ministry. Anytime we have an urgent prayer request or a crisis regarding one of our clients, all we need to do is send out an e-mail and they have us covered. It's amazing to watch God work through His people!

We also have three major fundraisers throughout the year — Baby Bottle Campaign, Spring Banquet, and Trivia. Attending or participating in these events is essential to the success of the ministry. Of course, your financial support is vital, but our fundraisers are also a wonderful way for us to introduce new people to our ministry.
